In 2013 - 2014, nineteen schools (primary, secondary and SEN) across England have taken part in creative learning projects inspired by The Full English digital archive*, led by the English Folk Dance and Song Society (EFDSS) and supported by the National Lottery through the Heritage Lottery Fund.

Projects have been led by professional folk musicians, dancers and storytellers, exploring traditional material from their local area. They demonstrate the successful use of folk arts to enhance learning in the school curriculum: from key stages 1 to 5 (including GCSE and A Level).
